

Sixth Form Admissions Appeal Information

Admissions Appeals are heard after GCSE results are released.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Appeals for Sixth Form places can only be heard after GCSE results are confirmed. This means you may miss the first few weeks of the school year. There will therefore be a certain amount of catch-up work you will be required to do as soon as possible after admission if your appeal is successful.
- GCSE results are released on **Thursday 20th August 2026**.

- Appeals are heard by an independent appeals panel within 30 school days of notification of exam results. You will be notified of the date and time of the appeal hearing 10 school days in advance.
- Evidence in support of your appeal must be submitted AT LEAST 10 working days in advance of the hearing date.
- Papers are circulated before the hearing.
- Decision letters are sent up to 5 working days after the panel has made its decision.
