Access to scripts

With your consent, your teachers can access your marked examination scripts.

This can help us to:

- support you with a query about a result
- review a script before considering next steps
- develop exemplar materials for future teaching and learning

Review of Marking

Standard review of marking checks whether the original marking was carried out correctly.

Priority review of marking is a faster service for A Level students whose university place depends on the outcome. It cost more and has a much earlier deadline.

There is no grade protection when you request a review of marking, your mark can:

↑ **INCREASE**

= **STAY THE SAME**

↓ **DECREASE**



What does it cost?

Post-Results Services are charged per exam paper /component, so the total cost will depend on the number of papers you ask us to submit.

CCS will cover the cost of a standard review of marking for one paper if you are within 1–2 marks of the next grade boundary.

If you are more than 2 marks away, the relevant awarding body fee will apply for each paper.

GCE (AS, A-level), Level 3 VTQ, GCSE and Level 1 & Level 2 VTQ qualifications

The post-results services available are:

- **Reviews of Results (RoRs)**: Clerical re-check; review of marking; review of moderation; Appeals
- **Access to scripts (ATS)**: Access to marked examination scripts
