This year has been like non other and it is a real testament to your children with how they have reacted and persevered to normalize school as much as possible.

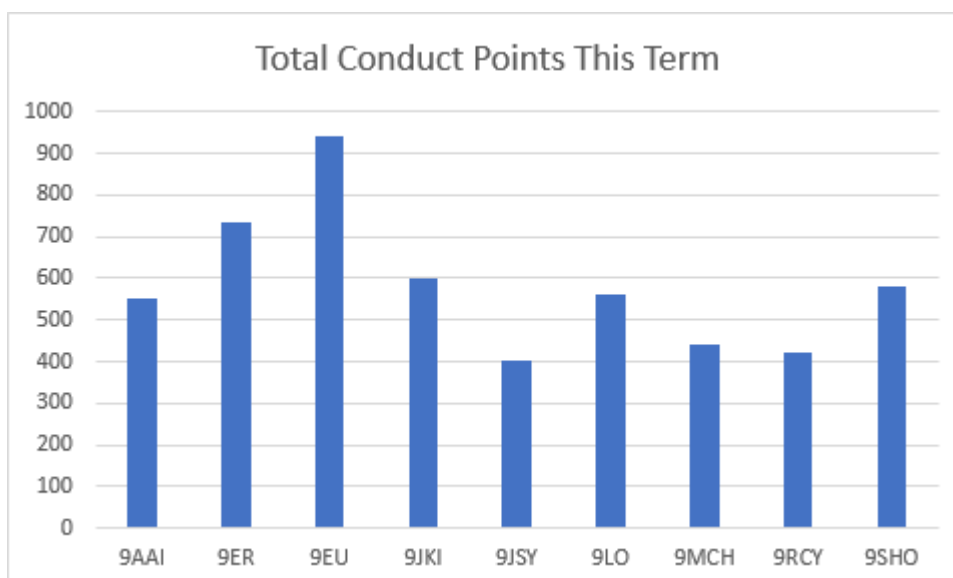
There will be more information to follow regarding the government's announcement in relation to the first week of term.
