

Residential Parental Consent

1. With due regard for the Principal of Caroline Chisholm School, Trip Leader or member of staff I allow my son/daughter to join the and in undertaking my son/daughter in the said **residential** I agree:
 - i) I shall instruct my child to wear a seat belt whilst travelling by motor vehicle and to abide by all safety instructions and behavioural requirements.
 - ii) To pay for any damages which may be occasioned solely through the proven misconduct or negligence of my son/daughter to the person or property of any other party or parties;
 - iii) I will not hold the Principal or members of staff responsible for any loss of personal effects or money incurred by my son/daughter during such visit where reasonable steps have been taken to safeguard such effects and money;
 - iv) I will indemnify him/her/them in respect of any expenses reasonably incurred in consequences of any accident to or illness of my son/daughter.

2. We would like to take this opportunity to draw parents and carers attention to the insurance "general exclusions" applicable for every trip. ACE Insurance shall not be liable for bodily injury loss or expense due to:

A) Suicide, attempted suicide or deliberate self-inflicted injury by the insured person regardless of the state of their mental health **B)** Illegal acts of the insured person.

This would mean that in the unlikely event of an incident of this nature occurs, under these exclusions the liability would lie with the parent or carer. If you would like a copy of the "general exclusions" or want to discuss any health needs further please contact Lisa West, SENCo.

3. I hereby authorise the Trip Leader or any other member of the school staff present, to consent to emergency treatment, which in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner may be necessary for my son/daughter during the course of the Caroline Chisholm School visit.

4. Please note that our insurance cover will not provide cover for medical expenses, repatriation cost, emergency travel or cancellation in circumstances where a student is travelling against medical advice

5. Parents are responsible for submitting the correct passport and EHIC details. The passport and EHIC must have a minimum of 6 months left on the documents, on the day of travel. If incorrect details are submitted the child may not be able to travel.

Please note: To be able to offer appropriate assistance in the event of any emergency this form must be completed in full with all relevant information relating to the student. *(Please use a separate sheet if necessary)*. If you feel that further discussion is required regarding any of the information that you have supplied, please contact the Trip Leader.
