We are pleased to announce two events coming up for our students in the next two weeks.

On Friday 18 June, we will be inviting our Secondary students to attend school in mufti in return for a minimum donation of £1. All donations will need to be paid through ParentPay, which will be open to Secondary parents from Friday 11 June as we cannot accept cash on the day. The focus for our non-uniform day will be led by our Sixth Form Med-Soc students. They want to raise awareness about the work offered by The Survivors Trust: a charity which has 120 member organisations based in the UK & Ireland providing specialist support for women, men and children who have survived rape, sexual violence, or childhood sexual abuse.
