Dear parents/carers,

Many of you will not have met your child's tutor in person, so this is an ideal opportunity to engage with the member of staff who has holistic overview for your child whilst they are in school. Appointments can be booked **via Edulink**. (Some tutor groups have two members of staff working with them, if this applies to your child's tutor group, please book your appointment with the member of staff who is highlighted in the table below in bold.)

The appointment system will open on **Wednesday 5 October at 9am** and can be accessed via Edulink. The booking system will close at **11am on Wednesday 12 October**.

Year 9 appointments will take place in **lower B block**. Appointments will run from 3.45-7.30pm. Upon arriving on site, please make your way to Main Reception where you will be directed towards the relevant block for your booked appointment.

We are still very early on in the academic year; therefore, tutors do not have insight into subject specific performance. They will be able to discuss how well your child has settled into the school year and give you the chance to raise any concerns about their wellbeing. If you do have any subject specific concerns, please contact the class teacher for that subject. Later in the academic year, there will be a subject evening to discuss your child's progress with each of their teachers.
