Governance responsibilities

The trust board works together to:

- developing a vision and strategy for the school/trust
- overseeing the financial performance of the organisation and making sure its money is well spent
- holding the school leaders to account to ensure that every pupil has the best possible education
- engaging with pupils, staff, parents and the school community to understand their views

Governance activities

- attending trust board meetings: these normally take place around six times a year and are outside school hours
- taking part in a committee: meetings are usually held three to four times a year and are held outside school hours
- looking at information and evidence on the school's progress and discussing with executive leaders
- visiting the school to see plans working in practice, and listening to the views of staff, pupils and parents
- undertaking induction training and ongoing development



Governance eligibility

To be eligible to volunteer as a trustee you need:

- the time to contribute
- to be aged 18 or over
- not to be disqualified under the relevant rules and procedures
- not to be a Caroline Chisholm School parent
