We are asking that during Week A, students prioritise Core Subject revision sessions and Week B they prioritise Option subjects. For example, if your child needs to attend Geography AND Maths revision, on a Week A they will go to Maths and a Week B they will attend Geography. We are hoping to offer breakfast sessions as well, but this is currently a work in progress.

On top of these specific sessions, we have also opened two classrooms at lunchtime for Year 11 students to access and work in. These are informal sessions, where students can bring their lunch with them and work with their peers on whatever they feel is necessary during that time. They can attend for some or all the lunchtime. Attendance at this before Christmas was successful so we are looking to continue that success this term. Year 11 have been given first access to the canteen for this term to help accommodate those wanting to attend revision sessions/lunchtime study club.

PPEs

Our second round of PPEs are looming. The timetable for this is on the next page. There are a few students who will experience a clash of exams. I would urge students to check their Edulink timetables to confirm timings. There is an opportunity for absence mop ups on Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 March. This is the last opportunity students will have to sit exams in the hall/sports hall before their GCSEs in May.

Students need to be aware that if they miss their exams in May/June, there will be no mop up opportunities. We would strongly encourage them to try and attend all PPE exams in this manner and not rely on having mop up opportunities.

A small reminder that students need to bring correct equipment to all exams and not rely on the exams team. The equipment we offer has often been used many times before by various students. If students have their own equipment, they are much more prepared for their exams.

We work closely with the Mental Health Support Team who can work with students on stress/exams/anxiety plus various other struggles they may be facing. Students won't thrive if their mental health isn't prioritised. We can help with this if we know they are struggling.

Teachers are here to help with the knowledge/skills/resources. Tutors are here to support with helping students to be prepared in other ways. We have a fantastic pastoral team who can also support students if they feel they need it too.

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Our Sixth Form Open Evening is taking place tonight (Wednesday 10 January), and I hope that many of our Year 11 students will be there to join us.

This is a great opportunity to view subjects that students may have studied already, but also subjects they won't have. They can speak to A Level specialist teachers, existing Sixth Form students and the Sixth Form team to gain an insight into life in Sixth Form.
