Creating Puzzles


How to create my own wordsearch

Have you ever tried to create your own wordsearch? Well, it is really a lot easier than you might imagine. Follow our four simple steps and you will be able to create a wordsearch on any topic you can think of.

All you need to get started is a blank wordsearch grid.

Step 1: Choose my theme


Your theme is the topic or subject you would like your wordsearch to be all about. What if you chose animals for your theme? Let's try that.



Beginner tip: Choose a theme that you are interested in or that you think other people would enjoy doing a wordsearch about.

Step 3: Place my words

Now it is time to place your words on the wordsearch grid. What if we started with a nice and easy layout with each word either written from left to right, top to bottom or diagonally?

Beginner tip: Make an easy wordsearch by writing your words from left to right, from top to bottom or diagonally (we call this 'diagonal business').

Professional tip: For a harder wordsearch, try writing some words from right to left (we call this backwards shenanigans) or bottom to top (we call this upsy-downsy-doodahs).

Legend tip: For an even harder wordsearch, you could even write words that change direction part way through (we call this an 'ultimate decoy'). Another idea is to place your words on the grid to form some sort of shape.

Step 4: Hide my words

The final step is to make your words hard to find by making sure every square in the wordsearch grid has a letter in it.

Beginner tip: Use a good mixture of letters from the whole alphabet. You could start by putting an 'A' in a square and then putting a 'B' in a different square somewhere else on the grid. Work your way through the alphabet and your grid will be full in no time.

Legend tip: Create some mischief by putting in some letters that very nearly match one of your words (we call this an 'almost word').
