We are delighted to be able to offer an impressive range of extra curricular activities for your child to choose from for terms 5 and 6.

This leaflet contains all the information you and your child will need to know to choose the activities they would like to participate in. You will find details of all clubs offered, including when they will run and by whom they will be run. Once you have made your selection, please complete the form at the back and return to the primary office as soon as possible.

Unless otherwise stated, children will attend their chosen club from the week beginning 22nd April until the week ending 12th July 2013.

Please note outdoor clubs are dependent on weather and may have to be cancelled on the same day of the club.

## Expedition Club (Years 4 & 5)

This club hopes to instil some survival skills with its members.



We will be using sessions to study map reading, low level hiking and camp craft including the correct use of tents and outdoor cooking.

Each week we will be looking at different area of outdoor learning that will culminate in a short hike and overnight camp in Term 6.

## Let's Get Cooking (Years 3 & 4)

Mrs Falconer and Miss Simmons will be taking Let's Get Cooking club this term and will sharing their passion for cooking and the skills involved to produce some simple yet tasty meals!

Each session will run on a **fortnightly** basis, for two hours, finishing at 5.15pm. All children participating in this club need to be committed to staying for the whole duration to allow for cooking times.

All ingredients for the cooking sessions will be provided free of charge.

Details about the session dates will be given to club members once the club begins.



## Netball (Years 4 - 6)

This is an energetic club which promises to get your child enjoying a team sport. A regular commitment is necessary as the team participates in several fixtures throughout the year.

Mrs Garrard will be running Netball club alongside Miss McIlwain, a keen netball player outside of school.



## Craft (Years 1 & 2)

Miss Hayes is looking for children who enjoy art, design and technology. This club will be using a variety of tools and techniques to produce a range of work using a wide variety of materials.

## Dodge ball (Year 2 - 6)

Mrs Langford and Mrs Meller will co-host our external Dodge ball instructor. During this club the children will learn the rules and skills of the this exciting game with the aim that we might be able to enter some teams in to some district tournaments.

Note this club costs **£3** per child, per session, paid in one instalment.

## STEM Club (Years 4 - 6)

Science club will be running bi-weekly with Mrs Pearmain and will be looking at introducing a series of different STEM activities to explore how things work and to develop a deeper understanding of the World around us.

## Code Club (Years 5 & 6)

This club is aimed at those interested in how computer systems are developed and controlled through code. Our two eager Six Form Computer Science students will take their club members through the writing of programmes using the visual programming language Scratch™.



## Origami (Years 2 & 3) - Term 5 only

Children will learn that not all gifts need to be bought and that they can be created using leftover gift paper to make a party hat or a fancy box. Children will learn that they need focus, concentration and patience in order to make decorations, cards and gifts from folded paper. Mrs Nimmo (nee Miss Emmins) will be leading this exciting club.

## MK Springers (Years 1 - 2)

We are lucky to have MK Springers Gymnastics to offer gymnastics for our Key Stage 1 classes. This club will offer a great introduction into gymnastics before progressing to the more difficult skills required to be the best.



Note this club costs **£3** per child, per session, paid in half termly instalments.

## Kickboxing (Years 3 - 6)

We have been really impressed with the progress of the Kickboxing club members this year and Mr Notice (external instructor) has requested that the existing club members continue so that they can complete more grading. This means that new members will only be able to join if existing members no longer wish to continue.

## Recorders (Years 2)

Mrs Hussain will be running a recorders club for the children across Year 2. Her weekly sessions will look to develop the children's musical skills in both playing the recorder and developing their sense of composition of new music.

## Zumba (Year 2 - 6)

Mrs Lapworth will be getting her dancing shoes on to join our Zumba instructor for this Friday after school club. If your child enjoys a giggle, a dance and wants to get fit this is the club for them.
