VISIT TO MOULTON COLLEGE

Over the next few months Year 11s will have to make an important decision about their future plans. We encourage students to consider having at least two options.

All year 11s are required to stay in education or training until they are 18. They can opt:

- To study full-time in a school, college or with a training provider
- To work or volunteer (over 20 hours a week) combined with part-time education or training
- For an apprenticeship

To help students explore and consider their future plans we will be offering them impartial advice, information and guidance to help them make their decision.

During the first term I have arranged three trips to:

Moulton and Northampton College (*Students can only visit one of these colleges*)

This activity aims to give students an impartial view of our local colleges; gain an insight of college life, the environment and find out about the courses they provide. We strongly recommend for students to attend an Open Event (dates will be advertised on our school website) to give them the opportunity to talk to tutors and current students.

The University of Northampton (*Students can only attend this activity if they did not attend a college trip*)

Students will receive an introduction to University. They will meet student ambassadors who can provide them with an insight of university life and will have a tour of the Campus including the hall of residence.

The first trip is to Moulton College on 19 September 2017. We will be departing school at 1230 p.m. and returning at 1500 p.m. Students are required to wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch. There are 63 places available and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis. A place will **only** be reserved with the return of a signed parent consent form. This trip will be free of charge.

If your son / daughter wish to attend the Moulton College trip, please complete the attached consent form and subject choice(s) and return it to Student Services by **NO LATER THAN THURSDAY 14 September**.
